SOUNDINGS IN FATHOMS

- Sand Banks dry at low water
- 1 to 2 fathoms &c.
- 20 to 25 fathoms
- Flood Stream
- Ebb Stream

The knots on the arrows show the strength of the stream at spring tides.
The soundings are given from low water at spring tides.
or float anchorage.
Enter the soundings 3 digits and in and 1 day 1 date at shell.
F. Flood R. Ebbing Light, H.W. High Water, L.W. Low Water.
Variation for 1871 - increasing annually about 2 minutes.
