



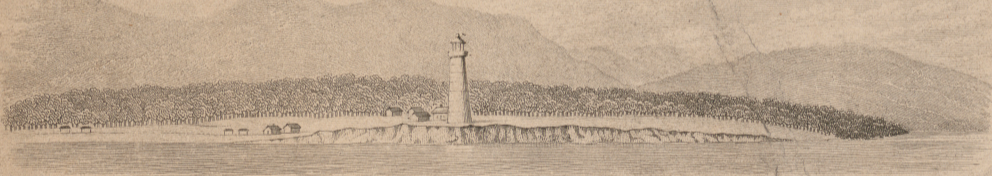

SURVEYED BY CAPT. H. W. BAYFIELD, R.N., F.R.S.  
1832.

H.W.F. & C. 19 50<sup>m</sup> Springs Rise 5 feet Tides 3 feet.  
Cape Gaspe S. East (Flower Pot Is.) Lat. 48° 45' 23" Long. 64° 9' 26" W.  
Magnetic Variation 1864, increasing 6' annually.

N.B. The Flower Pot Rock was thrown down by the ice in 1844,  
and the base is now only left and is marked at H.W.
