SOUNDINGS IN FEET

In this harbour there are two interesting tides, which sometimes produce two high waters. At the full & change they take place at 1st and 3rd, and low water at 2nd, the fall in that interval seldom exceeding a foot. The whole rise at spring is 4 feet, and at Neap 2 feet, and are regular by the tides.
Magnetic Variation 1861 increasing about 6' annually.
