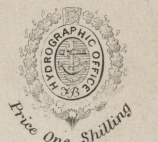
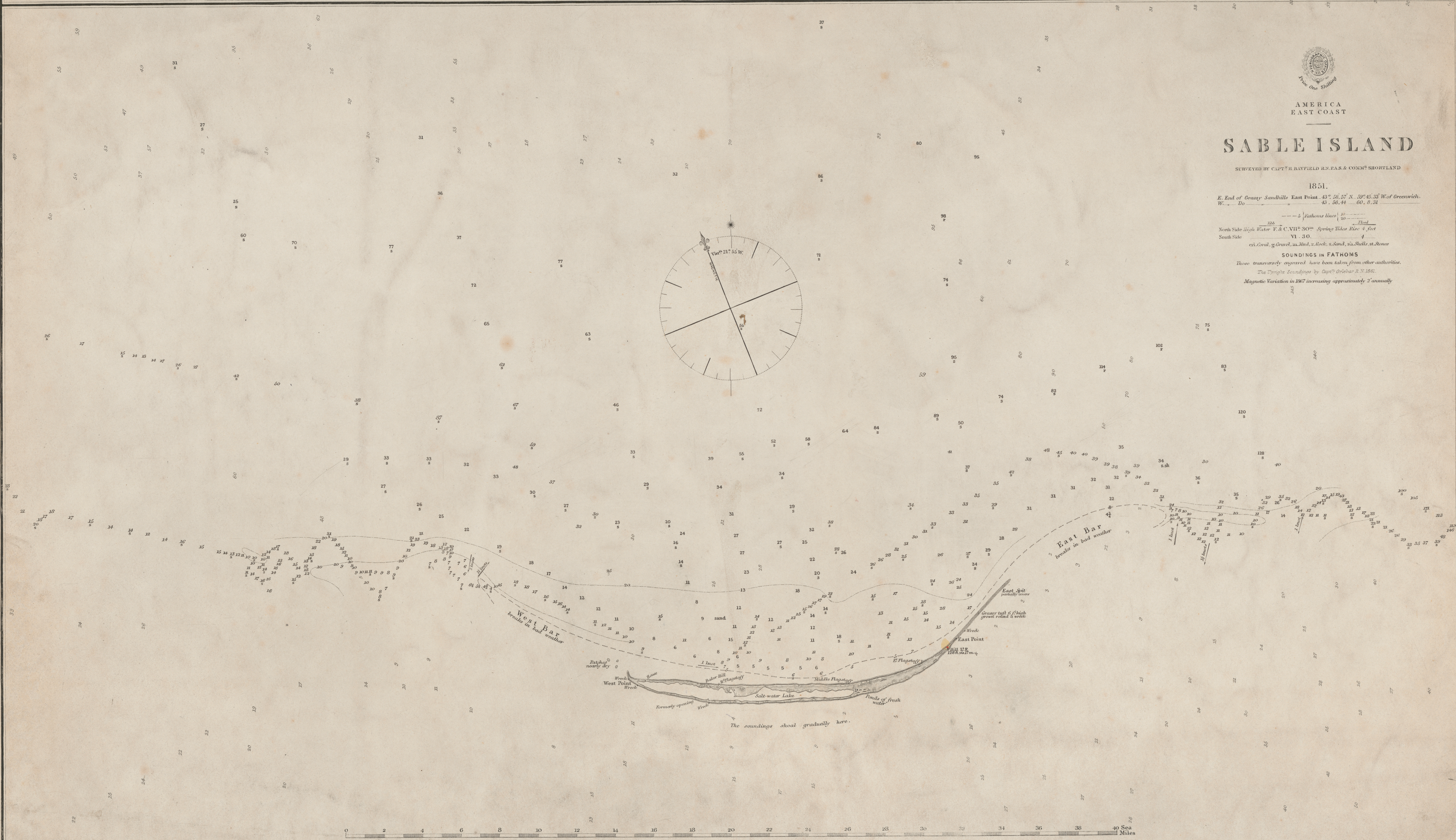


SABLE ISLAND
