- 1 AMHERST From Place d'Armes (East side) to Laurier and Papineau. -via Notre-Dame, Goyard, Craig, Amherst, Park, Lafontaine, Delarochette, Gifford, Delarochette, Laurier. -Return via Laurier, Chambray, Gifford, Delarochette, Park Lafontaine, Amherst, Craig, Goyard, Notre-Dame and St. James. After 7.00 p.m. from Champ-de-Mars.
- 2 CENTRE From Place d'Armes (West side) to d'Argeon -via St. James, McGill, Wellington, and Centre. -Return via Centre, Wellington, McGill and Notre-Dame.
- 3 ST. CATHERINE From Place d'Armes (West side) to Victoria and Sherbrooke -via Viau, St. Catherine, Victoria Avenue. -Return via Sherbrooke, Greene Avenue, St. Catherine, St. Clement and Notre-Dame.
- 4 ST. CATHERINE - DOMINION PARK From Victoria -via Sherbrooke, Greene, St. Catherine, St. Clement, Notre-Dame to Dominion Park. -Return via Notre-Dame, Viau, St. Catherine, Victoria, Sherbrooke.
- 5 ONTARIO From Victoria Square (north side) to Notre-Dame and Viau -via Craig, Bleury, Ontario, Viau, St. Catherine, St. Clement. -Return via Viau and same route.
- 6 NOTRE DAME - DOMINION PARK From Place d'Armes (East side) -via Notre-Dame street to Dominion Park. -Return via Notre-Dame and St. James.
- 7 MOUNT ROYAL From Park Avenue -via Mount-Royal to Ierville.
- 8 TETREAUVILLE From Lasalle and Notre-Dame to Tetreauville -via Lasalle, to Terminal private right of way to Park Terminal, Daylong and Tetreauville. -Return via same route and Lasalle, Ontario and Letourneau.
- 9 ST. DENIS-WINDSOR From Victoria Square to Parthenais -via St. Denis, Windsor, University, St. Catherine, St. James, Duluth, St. Andre and Mary-Ann. -Return via Mary Ann, St. Andre, Duluth, St. Denis, St. Catherine, Peel, Windsor.
- 10 PAPINEAU (upper) From C. P. R. Tracks to Belanger.
- 12 DELORMIER-WINDSOR From Windsor and St. Antoine to Rachel -via St. Antoine, Craig and Delormier. -Return via Delormier, Craig, Little Craig, St. James and Windsor. After 8.00 p.m. and on Sundays on Delormier only.
- 14 GUY-BEAVER HALL - WESTMOUNT BLVD From Place d'Armes (west side) from Victoria Square after 7.00 p.m. and on Sunday -via St. James, Beaver Hall, Dorchester, Guy, Cote-des-Neiges Road, Westmount, Sherbrooke, Atwater, St. James, Inspector, Notre-Dame to Place d'Armes.
- 15 ST. CATHERINE (short line) From Harbour -via St. Catherine to Atwater loop.
- 16 ST. JAMES WEST, N. D. DE GRACE From St. James and Glen Avenue to Girouard -via St. James.
- 17 ST. LAURENT-CARTIERVILLE From Mount Royal and Park Avenue to Cartierville -via Park Avenue, Laurier, St. Catherine Road, Bellingham Road, Manneville, Decelles, Queen Mary Road, Snowdon Junction and by private right-of-way to St. Laurent and Cartierville.
- 20 ST. HELEN ISLAND (Autobus) From St. Denis -via Craig, Berrit to St. Helen Island Ferry, Victoria Pier.
- 21 BRIDGE (Autobus) From Wellington and Bridge to Britannia -via Bridge street to Britannia. -Return via Britannia, Menal, Fort and same route.
- 22 NOTRE DAME EAST From Place d'Armes (East side) to Viau and Notre-Dame -via Notre-Dame -Return via Viau, St. Catherine, St. Clement, Notre-Dame and St. James.
- 23 ST. DENIS-AHUNTSIC From Victoria Square (north side) to Ahuntsic -via Craig, St. Denis, Isabeau, Lajeunesse, Cremazie Boulevard and private right-of-way -Return via private right-of-way, Cremazie Boulevard, St. Denis, Craig.
- 25 NOTRE DAME-COTE ST. PAUL From Place d'Armes to Lasalle Road (Verdun) -via St. James, McGill, Notre-Dame, Cote St. Paul Road, Church, Wellington, Rielle -Return via Lasalle Road, Gordon and same route.
- 29 OUTREMONT-YOUVILLE From Youville loop to Bellingham Road -via McGill, Craig Bleury, Park Avenue, Laurier, St. Catherine Road.
- 31 ST. HENRI-CHAMP DE MARS From Champ-de-Mars to Glen Avenue -via Craig, Little Craig, St. James.
- 33 NOTRE DAME-POINTE-AUX-TREMBLES From Place d'Armes (East side) -via Notre-Dame to Pointe-aux-Trembles direct.
- 35 ST. DENIS-CHRISTOPHE-COLOMB From Victoria Square (north side) to Belanger -via Craig, St. Denis, Fleury and Christophe Colomb.
- 36 NOTRE DAME-VILLE EMARD From Place d'Armes to Allard -via St. James, McGill, Notre-Dame, Cote St. Paul Road, Church, St. Patrick, Monk Blvd.
- 39 PIE IX AVENUE From Notre-Dame to Papineau -via Letourneau, Ontario, Pie IX, Boulevard, Rosemont Boulevard.
- 40 BORDEAUX-MONTREAL NORD From Belvoir and Poincaré to Montreal North -via McDuff, Mellish, Daze, Tolhurst, Kelly, Ahuntsic, Sault-au-Rouelle, Montreal Nord.
- 43 PARK AVENUE-ATWATER From Mile End C.P.R. Station to Atwater and St. Luke -via Bernad, Park Avenue, Bleury, St. Catherine West, Atwater. -Return via Closse and same route.
- 44 PAPINEAU From Place d'Armes (East side) to C.P.R. tracks -via Notre-Dame, Goyard, Craig and Papineau -Return via same route and St. James.

- 47 ST. ANTOINE-WESTMOUNT BLVD. From Victoria Square (west side) to Laurier and Papineau. -via St. Antoine, Avator, Sherbrooke, Chateaufort, Victoria Avenue, Lansdowne, Westmount Boulevard, Cote des Neiges Road, Guy, Dorchester, Beaver Hall, St. James, McGill, Notre-Dame to Place d'Armes.
- 49 ST. HENRI-MCGILL From Victoria Square to Glen Avenue -via St. James -Return via St. Antoine to Victoria Square.
- 52 MOUNT ROYAL-ATWATER From Place d'Armes (west side) to Atwater -via Mount Royal, Park Avenue, Bleury, St. Catherine West, Atwater, St. Luke -Return via Closse and same route. After 7.00 p.m. on Mount Royal Avenue only.
- 53 LACHINE RAPIDS From Rielle and Lasalle Road to Ville Lasalle -via Lasalle Road.
- 55 ST. LAURENT-ISABEAU From Place d'Armes (West side) to St. Denis and Isabeau -via Notre-Dame, St. Laurent Boulevard, Belchasse, St. Dominique, Isabeau -Return via same route and St. James.
- 57 ST. DENIS-VILLERAY From McGill -via Craig, St. Denis, Isabeau, Lajeunesse, Jarry to St. Denis -Return via St. Denis and Craig.
- 58 WELLINGTON From Place d'Armes (west side) to Lasalle Road -via St. James, Inspector, Notre-Dame, McGill, Wellington, Rielle Avenue -Return via Lasalle Road, Gordon Avenue, Wellington, McGill, Notre-Dame.
- 64 NOTRE DAME DE GRACE From Place d'Armes (West side) -via St. James, Atwater, Sherbrooke to Elmhurst -Return via Sherbrooke, Atwater, St. James, Inspector, Notre-Dame. From 5 to 9 a.m. and 5 to 6 p.m. week days except Saturday.
- 65 COTE DES NEIGES From Westmount Boulevard and Cote des Neiges Hill to Queen Mary Road -via Cote des Neiges Road.
- 66 IBERVILLE From Ierville and Masson to Belanger -via Ierville.
- 68 ST. DENIS-CREMAZIE From McGill to Cremazie -via Craig, St. Denis, Isabeau, Lajeunesse, Cremazie -Return via Cremazie, St. Denis, Craig, McGill. (From 5 to 6 p.m. on week days only.)
- 70 WINDSOR-MONTREAL WEST From Place d'Armes (west side) to Parkside Avenue -via St. James, Windsor, Peel, St. Catherine, Greene Ave., Sherbrooke and Westminster -Return via Westminster, Sherbrooke, Victoria, St. Catherine, Peel Windsor, St. James, Inspector, Notre-Dame.
- 72 ST. DENIS-FRONTENAC From Harbour and St. Catherine to Jarry -via St. Catherine, St. Denis, Isabeau, Lajeunesse -Return via St. Denis and same route. NOT out on Sunday.
- 74 MOUNTAIN-MOUNT ROYAL From Ierville to Victoria Avenue -via Mount Royal, Park Avenue, Laurier, St. Catherine Road, Bellingham Road, Manneville, Decelles, Queen Mary Road, Snowdon Junction and by private right-of-way to St. Laurent and Cartierville. (On Sundays only during summer months.)
- 76 PARK AVENUE EXTENSION From C.P.R. tracks to Hall Avenue via Park Avenue, Beaumont, Bremer.
- 77 ST. LAURENT-MILE END From Place d'Armes (East side) to Mile End Station -via Notre-Dame, St. Laurent to Mile End Station Loop. -Return via St. Laurent, St. James to Place d'Armes.
- 79 GUY STREET (Lower) From St. Catherine and Guy to Centre -via Guy, Notre-Dame, Seleneux, St. Patrick and Shearer.
- 80 BLEURY From Champ de Mars to Atlantic -via Craig, Bleury, Park Avenue. After 7.00 p.m. from Cote Street to Atlantic.
- 83 WINDSOR-SNOWDON From Place d'Armes to Snowdon Junction -via St. James, Windsor, Peel, St. Catherine, Greene Avenue, Sherbrooke, Girouard and Queen Mary Road -Return via Queen Mary Road, Girouard, Sherbrooke, Victoria, St. Catherine, Peel, Windsor, St. James, Inspector and Notre-Dame. After 8.00 p.m. on Sunday from Snowdon to Victoria Avenue only.
- 87 DAVIDSON From Ontario to Nolan (C.P.R. Angus shops) -via Davidson.
- 89 POINTE AUX TREMBLES From Viau and Notre-Dame to Pointe aux Trembles -via Notre-Dame to Longue Pointe, Montreal East.
- 90 BOUT DE L'ILE From Notre-Dame and Lasalle to Bout de l'ile -via Viau, then via private right-of-way to Park Terminal, Daylong, Tetreauville, Terrace Way, Montreal East, Pointe aux Trembles, Cote St. Laurent, Belchasse and Ahuntsic. -Return by same route to Lasalle, Ontario, Letourneau and Notre-Dame.
- 91 LACHINE From Place d'Armes (West side) to Stoney Point -via St. James, St. Henri Place, Notre-Dame, Cote St. Paul Road, then via private right-of-way to Park Terminal, Daylong, Tetreauville, Terrace Way, Montreal East, Pointe aux Trembles, Cote St. Laurent, Belchasse and Ahuntsic. -Return by same route to Cote St. Paul Road and Notre-Dame.
- 95 FRONTENAC From Notre-Dame and Frontenac to 11th Avenue, Rosemont -via Frontenac, Rachel, Ierville and Masson.
- 96 VAN HORNE From Champ de Mars to Harland Avenue -via Craig, Bleury, Park Avenue, Bleury, Outremont Avenue and Van Horne Avenue -After 7.00 p.m. from Harland to Atwater Avenue -via St. Catherine West.
- 97 GLEN From Glen Avenue and St. James to St. Catherine -via Glen Avenue.
- 98 RACHEL From St. Lawrence Boulevard to Park Lafontaine -via Rachel.
- 99 OBSERVATION CAR From Peel -via St. Catherine, Bleury, Park Avenue, St. Catherine Road, Bellingham, Maplewood, Decelles, Queen Mary Road, Girouard, Sherbrooke, Victoria Avenue, St. Catherine to Peel.
