

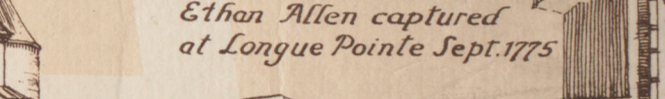
Royal coat of arms of France used, with modification, on civic legal documents, during French regime
