The Officers and Members of the McGill University Contingent, Canadian Officers Training Corps, are prepared to give four months' rapid training to all men of military age and good standing desirous of fitting themselves as soldiers.

Commencing May 25th, 1916, parades will be held on the McGill University Campus on Tuesday and Thursday Evenings at 7.45 p.m., and alternate Saturday Afternoons at 2.45 p.m.

Instructions will be given in Squad, Platoon and Company Drill, Musketry Exercises, Bayonet Fighting and Signalling. Field Manoeuvres, Tactical Schemes and Night Operations will be made a feature of the training.

Applications may be made to McGill C.O.T.C. Headquarters, 425 Sherbrooke Street West, between 4 and 10 p.m., on and after May 15th, 1916. Applicants must pass satisfactory medical examination by the Medical Officer of McGill Contingent C.O.T.C. Uniforms will be supplied.

Enrollment for the four months' training will not mean enlistment in the McGill Contingent C.O.T.C., or for Overseas Service.
